CHICKEN FACTS

Chicken is a budget-friendly form of protein, costing an average of only \$1.25 per pound based on national averages.

Chicken is naturally low in sodium, providing only 70 milligrams of sodium per three ounce portion.

Chicken without the skin is naturally low in fat -- only three grams of fat per three ounce cooked portion (about the size of a deck of cards). Even with the skin, chicken provides a modest eight grams of fat per three ounce portion.
